

Venerable Kai Li

Chinese Buddhism – Mahayana (Malaysia / Plum Village)

Venerable Kaili, a Sabahan born in 1967, ordained as a Buddhist monk under Venerable Boon Keng at Ang Hock See temple in Penang, Malaysia in 1989. Venerable Kaili took the full Bhikkhu precepts at Miao-Fa temple, in Xin-Ying, Taiwan in 1993.

Ven Kaili has studied in the Buddhist Institute of Malaysia from 1991 to 1993 and Fuyen Buddhist Institute in Taiwan from 1993 to 1999.

Since 1999, Venerable Kaili went to Myanmar, Korea and France to learn and practice meditation under the Venerable Pa-Auk Taw Sayadaw, the Venerable U Tejaniya Sayadaw, the Venerable U Janaka Sayadaw, Zen Master Seung Sahn's disciple, the late Mu Shim Sunim and Venerable Master Thich Nhat Hanh. In recent years, the Venerable Bhikkhu Kaili shares his deep experiences by leading mindfulness retreat and giving Dhamma talks in France, Malaysia, US and China. His focus is practicing "right mindfulness with clear comprehension" in daily life.
